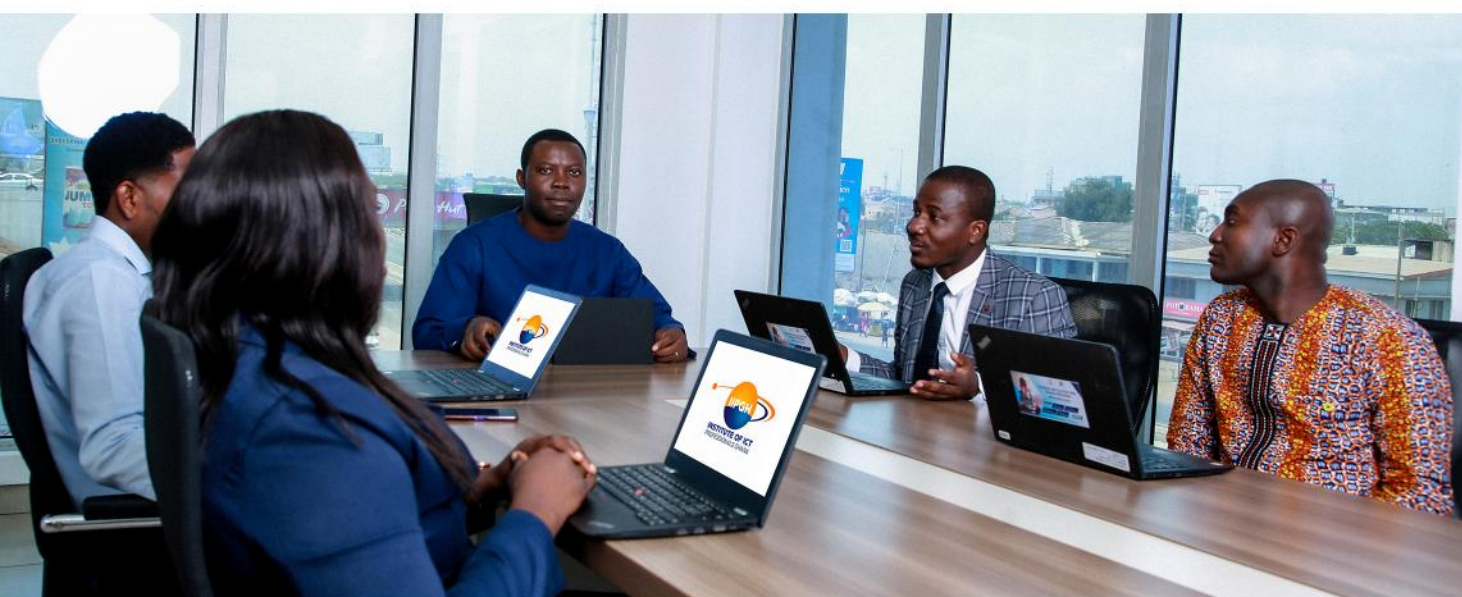

MAJOR INITIATIVES



Tech Job Fair

Debates have always been rife as to whether the graduate unemployment situation in Ghana is occasioned by lack of job openings or a mismatch of skills in relation to the available jobs. It is in response to this quandary that the concept of a Tech Job Fair (TJF) was conceived and birthed in 2020. The main objective of the Fair has been to bring together companies looking for new talents, on one hand, and job seeking graduates on the other, to exhibit and fill up job openings through an innovative rapid recruitment process. The 2023 edition (following that of the previous year) was held at the Accra International Conference Centre (AICC) on February 22, 2023 under the theme, **Leveraging Technology to Create Inclusive and Sustainable Jobs.**



Participation

Participation in the Fair for ICT-related companies is strictly by invitation based on track record in the tech industry. These companies will have access to a large pool of fresh talents seeking their very first job breakthroughs, as well as experienced professionals seeking to switch jobs or careers. What is significant is that job seekers will be screened through an online registration process to ensure high quality participation. It is also important to add that, beyond onsite participation at AICC, provision will be made for virtual participation. This is to ensure that as many companies and individuals that are interested would have the opportunity to participate in the Fair.



Industry-Academia Tech Dialogue

INDAC-TED (INDUSTRY-ACADEMIA TECH DIALOGUE) is a knowledge-sharing quarterly symposium that seeks to bring together and foster closer collaboration among education providers and industry players: educators, businesses and organizations, students, policymakers among others for an industry-academia dialogue on ICT development in various fields, to create opportunities for businesses and the youth. It is a platform to discuss issues of skills development, capacity building, and employment. It targets business and employment opportunities and how to unlock sustainable jobs in relevant emerging technologies knowledge areas.



Cybersecurity Awareness

• Cybersecurity Quarterly Webinar

IIPGH and its supporting organization(s), by this quarterly program, seek to contribute to and drive a Safer Digital Ghana, enhancing development and capacity-building of its members and the public, and networking among ICT stakeholders in Ghana. Cybersecurity Awareness Month (NCSAM) National Cybersecurity Awareness Month is a collaborative effort between government and industry to ensure every Ghanaian has the resources they need to stay safe and secure online, to create awareness and educate citizens on the importance of good cyber hygiene, while increasing the resilience of the nation against cyber threats. It is an annual event spearheaded by the National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC) of the Ministry of Communications and Digitalisation (MoCD).



Tech Entrepreneurs Forum



Tech Entrepreneurs Forum is an event initiated by the Institute of ICT Professionals Ghana to provide a networking platform for corporate organizations, SMEs, and start-up organizations to exhibit their products and/or services in emerging technologies. The maiden edition was held in February 2019. Furthermore, create a platform for collaboration between tech entrepreneurs within the ecosystem to connect and find synergies for service delivery and customer experience. It aims at bringing experts in some key emerging technologies to help shape the conversations on opportunities in the digital space for technology entrepreneurs.

The Coding Caravan



The Coding Caravan is a digital skills awareness program as part of the Coding Education for Ghana Initiative of IIPGH. Since 2018, the Institute has introduced coding to young ones starting from age 8, involving three different stakeholders in the industry, and ten (11) different centers/schools in 5 regions of Ghana. With a vision of taking the coding program beyond the national capital, IIPGH in August 2021 birthed a Coding Caravan initiative that toured the southern parts of the country with a mission to introduce coding to young people. The caravan kicked off in Accra and made stopovers in the Central, Western, Eastern, and Volta regions. Targeting pupils, teachers/trainers, schools, communities, educators, and policymakers in Ghana. The Coding Caravan introduces coding basics to young ones, aiming at implementing creative ideas-as one can create computer games, interactive animations and graphics, and many other applications. It offers all children and beginners an easy and playful introduction to programming.
